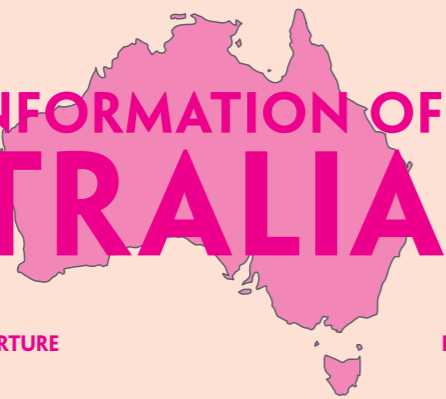


GENERAL INFORMATION OF AUSTRALIA



A) PREPARATION BEFORE DEPARTURE

- 1) Travel Documents
 - i) Tour member must have:
 - The necessary visa and health certificates as required by the various authorities of the countries to be visited.
 - An international passport or other recognized travel document which should be valid for at least 6 months from the date of return to country of origin.
- 2) Travel insurance is strongly recommended to purchase before travel as medical fee is expensive.
- 3) Kindly make sure all check-in luggages are properly tagged for easy identification.

B) FOOD

Strictly not allowed to bring into Australia as according to the immigration leaflets 'HELP TO PROTECT AUSTRALIA' like fresh fruits, dry meats, food, seafood and others prohibited items – further details refer to www.daff.gov.au

C) MEDICINE

For own consumption only (Declaration needed upon arrival for custom inspection)

D) WEATHER – based on celcius (°c) and subject to daily changes

DAY 1 KUALA LUMPUR → SYDNEY

Assemble at KLIA for check in and fly to Australia – SYDNEY. Overnight flight.

DAY 2 ARRIVAL SYDNEY – BLUE MOUNTAINS

Upon arrival, proceed to visit **Featherdale Wildlife Park**: Meet native Australian animals. Get up close to koalas and even handfeed kangaroos.

Blue Mountains (Include Scenic World Discovery Ride): Katoomba region and visit the beautiful forest valley of the Blue Mountains, view the Three Sisters rock formation between Jamison and Burratorang valley from Echo Point and proceed to Scenic World for unlimited pass of the Scenic Skyway, Railway and Cableway. After that, transfer back to Sydney.

DAY 3 BLUE MOUNTAINS – SYDNEY

Echo Point: Echo Point lookout is on the traditional land of the Gundungurra and Darug People. Perched on the edge of the escarpment in Katoomba, it has panoramic views of the Jamison Valley and the iconic Three Sisters.

DFO Outlet: They are large-floor warehouse buildings containing partitioned stores where retail outlets sell excess or previous seasons' stocks at reduced prices.

DAY 4 SYDNEY – WOLLONGONG – SYDNEY

Dolphin Cruise: With approximately 100 bottlenose dolphins, it's no wonder these friendly locals are sighted so often.

Kiama Blowhole: The name 'Kiama' has long been translated as "where the sea makes a noise". Under certain sea conditions, the blowhole can spray 50 litres of water up to 25 metres in the air, in quantities that thoroughly drench any bystanders.

Grand Pacific Drive: Starting in the Royal National Park it crosses the Sea Cliff Bridge and continues through Wollongong, Shellharbour, Kiama, and Shoalhaven on a total length of 140 km.

DAY 5 SYDNEY

Sydney City Tour: Inclusive of photo stop at Mrs. Macquarie's Chair, over view of Sydney Opera House, Sydney Harbour Bridge, The Rocks, Parliament House, bypass King's Cross, Darling Harbour, Star City Casino, Queen Victoria Building and Chinatown.

Paddy's Markets: Is a commercial enterprise that has two large markets in Sydney. Paddy's Markets are located in Haymarket and Flemington and specialise in the sale of fruit, vegetables, fish, clothes and giftware.

Bondi Beach: Bondi Beach is famous for its glistening ocean, pristine sands reliable surf and seaside spirit. Its laidback coastal lifestyle, café culture, boutique shops and thriving, eclectic community is equally enticing.

Vivid Night Tour: One of the biggest events in Australia annually. It is the world's largest festival of light, music and ideas.

DAY 6 SYDNEY → KUALA LUMPUR

After breakfast, check-out of hotel and transfer to Sydney International Airport for departure flight back to Kuala Lumpur with lots of sweet memories of your pleasant holiday in Australia. Thank you and see you again.

第一天 吉隆坡 → 悉尼

集合于吉隆坡国际机场，办理登机手续，乘搭客机飞往澳大利亚悉尼。

第二天 悉尼 – 蓝山国家公园

抵达后，前往游览 **费瑟黛尔野生动物园**：野生动物园拥有超过1,700种本土动物。游客可以近距离接触考拉和亲手喂养袋鼠。

蓝山国家公园 (包括蓝山风景世界无限通行证)：一睹传奇的三姐妹岩奇，乘搭铁路与缆车探索蓝山国家公园大自然宝库。

第三天 蓝山国家公园 – 悉尼

Echo Point 瞭望台：坐落在悬崖的边缘，位于卡通巴，享有贾米森谷和标志性三姐妹的全景。沿着悬崖边缘经过许多风景优美的观景台。

DFO直销店：它们是大型仓库建筑，包含分区商店，零售店以较低的价格出售多余的或前一季的库存。

第四天 悉尼 – 卧龙岗 – 悉尼

船游观赏海豚：搜索大约有100只生活在清澈海水里的瓶鼻海豚，在此有机会看到瓶鼻海豚飞跃。

凯阿马喷水孔：凯阿马喷水孔是澳大利亚新南威尔士州凯阿马镇的一个气孔。在某些海况下，气孔可以在空气中喷射50升水直至25米。

太平洋大道：是澳大利亚风景优美的车道。从皇家国家公园开始，它穿过海崖大桥，继续穿过卧龙岗，谢尔哈伯，凯阿马和肖尔黑文，全长140公里。

第五天 悉尼

悉尼市区游：包括到麦考里夫人座椅拍照留念，悉尼歌剧院，悉尼海港大桥，乐士区，国会大厦，途经国王十字路，达令港，星城赌场，维多利亚女王大楼，及唐人街。

帕迪市场：在悉尼拥有两个大型的超市。帕迪市场位于海伊街和弗莱明顿，专门销售水果，蔬菜，鱼，衣服和礼品。

邦代海滩：是悉尼一个很著名的海滩。

缤纷悉尼灯光音乐节：世界著名的灯光、音乐和创意盛会。是澳大利亚一年一度最大的活动之一。

第六天 悉尼 → 吉隆坡
