**第1天 吉隆坡 / 桃园 (台北)**

在吉隆坡国际机场集合, 搭乘豪华客机飞往台北。

**桃园夜市:** 贩卖类别一应俱全, 琳琅满目, 其中多样的人气美食更无法一言尽之, 来一趟桃园观光夜市, 绝对不虚此行!

**酒店住宿:** 桃园蜜月世纪或同级

**第2天 桃园 - 台北 - 十分车站 - 九份老街 - 宜兰 - 汤围沟公园 - 头城休闲农场 (早/晚 - 农场 BBQ)**

**十分车站:** 除了可体验在火车轨道上释放天灯乐趣, 您还可目睹全台湾独一无二的火车穿过老店前的铁路之奇景 (天灯自费)。

**九份老街:** 它是昔日的金矿产区, 也是今日的电影“悲情城市”的外景地。那里可以品尝草仔粿、蕃薯芋头丸、潮州鱼丸等各式小吃。

**汤围沟温泉公园:** 是礁溪境内相当热门的泡汤地点。

**头城休闲农场:** 体验台湾农村生活 (可爱动物园区, 水稻文化等) 乡村风味 BBQ 和祈福小天灯。

**酒店住宿:** 宜兰头城休闲农场或同级

**第3天 宜兰 - 玉兔铅笔学校 - 三星葱农场 - 罗东林业文化园区 - 罗东夜市 (早/午 - 兰阳料理)**

**玉兔铅笔学校:** 这里有好多好玩教学和游戏, 等着你来体验 - 含生产线导览、团康游戏, 铅笔DIY,

**三星葱农场:** 葱油饼DIY。

**罗东林业文化园区:** 占地约 20 公顷, 目前规划有自然生态池(贮木池)、水生植物池、水生植物展示区(培育荷花、穗花棋盘脚、睡莲等数十种水生植物)、运材蒸汽火车头展示区、森林铁路、临水木栈道等设施。

**罗东夜市:** 贩卖各种传统风味的小吃、商品, 平价服饰店、鞋店、小吃店等, 还有龙凤腿、台湾咸卤味、包心粉圆等都是闻名全台的小吃料理, 其中以肉羹番最负盛名, 以独特风味的肉卷在国宴料理中打响名号, 更是成为生意强强滚的店家, 吸引不少游客前往品尝。

**酒店住宿:** 宜兰民宿或同级

**第4天 宜兰 - 台北 - 山地特产中心 - 忠烈祠 - 貔貅展示馆 - 101 购物中心 - 维格烘焙坊 - 西门町 (早/午 - 金品小笼包)**

**忠烈祠:** 奉祀为国捐躯的先贤先烈, 值得到此体会早年烈士牺牲奉献的精神, 同时台北市目前主要有可以观看三军仪对卫兵交接的地点。

**101 购物中心:** 台北地标。这里有许多进口名牌店。在台湾最高的大楼享受宽广、舒适的购物乐趣。

**西门町商圈:** 台北著名的购物天堂尽情享受逛街购物。

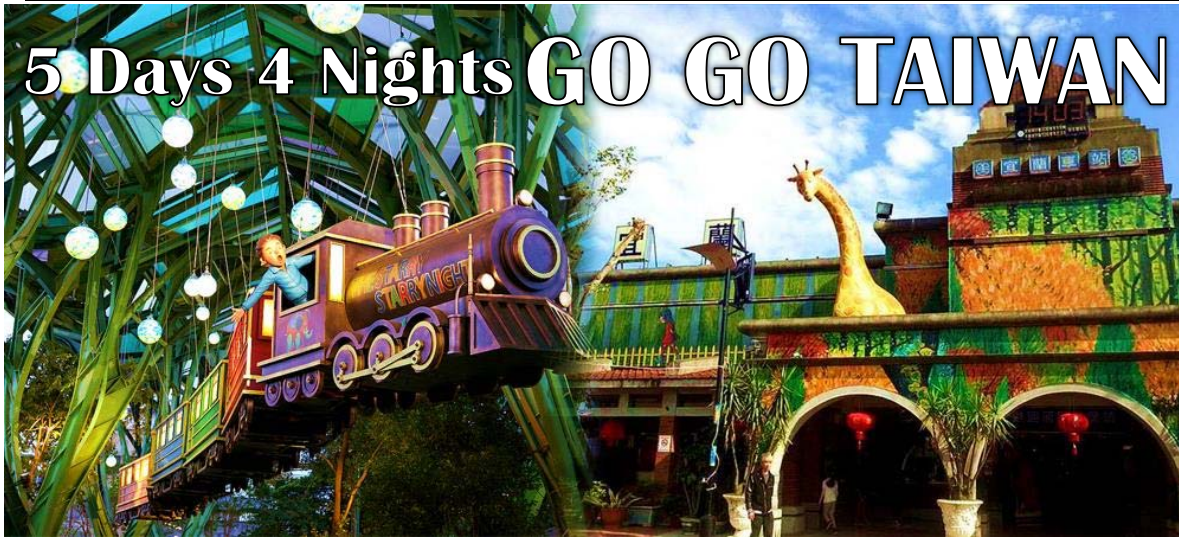
**酒店住宿:** 台北万事达西门或同级

## DAY 1 KUALA LUMPUR/ TAOYUAN ( TAIPEI)

Assemble at KLIA for your flight to Taipei.

**Taoyuan Night Market:** covers a total length of about 3Km with around 265 stalls. Most stalls are focused on traditional cuisines and snacks.

**Hotel :** Taoyuan Century or similar

## DAY 2 TAOYUAN - TAIPEI – SHIFEN STATION – JIUFEN OLD STREET – YILAN – TANGWEI SPRINGS PARK – TOUCHENG LEISURE FARM (B/ D – FARM BBQ)

**Shifen Station:** to experience the joy of lighting and releasing sky lanterns with your fellow travelers (**own expense for sky lanterns**).

**Jiufen Old Street:** a prosperous village with many teahouses and shop selling famous local dishes, snacks and crafts.

**Tangwei Springs Park:** the park features elaborately designed green landscape with viewing pavilion, outdoor foot spa, and old-fashioned juniper spa.

**Toucheng Leisure Farm:** experience DIY activities and writing wishes on the sky lantern.

**Hotel :** Yilan Toucheng Leisure Farm or similar

## DAY 3 YILAN – RABBIT PENCIL FACTORY – SPRING ONION FARM – LUODONG FORESTRY CULTURE GARDEN - LUODONG NIGHT MARKET (B/ L – YILAN SPECIALTY)

**Rabbit Pencil Factory:** has transformed into a tourist factory, in which a quaint classroom has been built to bring back the memory of visitors' schooldays. DIY workshops are also held to allow visitors to make their own pencils by hands.

**Spring Onion Farm:** DIY Onion Pancake.

**Luodong Forestry Culture Garden:** the garden has a timber pond, forest railway, bamboo forest station, steam locomotive, green forest, and trails. You can see from the equipment and buildings how prosperous and vibrant the forestry was at the time.

**Luodong Night Market:** It is one of the biggest and most crowded night market in Taiwan.

**Hotel :** Yilan Home Stay or similar

## DAY 4 YILAN – TAIPEI – LINGZHI SPECIALTY CENTRE – MARTYRS' SHRINE - LUCKY CHARM CENTRE – 101 SHOPPING MALL - PINEAPPLE TART SHOP – XIMENTING (B/ L - SOUP DUMPLINGS (XIAO LONG BAO)

**Martyrs' Shrine:** to observe the changing of guards processing ceremony.

**101 Shopping Mall:** where you can find numerous imported branding here.

**Ximinteng:** is currently already being called the "Harajuku of Taipei". It is considered to be the place to see and be seen most especially for the younger crowd.

**Hotel :** Taipei Wonstar Ximen or similar

## DAY 5 TAIPEI - TAOYUAN/ KUALA LUMPUR (B – HOTEL OR PACKED BREAKFAST)

If time permits, you can do some last- minute shopping before you transfer to the airport for your flight home.
